Thank you to those who completed our food service survey found on the L-M website last week. After looking at the results we believe that it would be beneficial for L-M schools to provide a lunch packet drop on a weekly basis through the month of June. We will have a pick-up from 11:00-12:00 every Wednesday at the Fruitland Community Center, Grandview Park, Letts Library, and the Elementary School Kitchen Dock. I will try to give everyone a reminder on Tuesday night about this service.

**The 2020 Graduation Ceremony is scheduled for June 28th.
The 2020 L-M Prom has been cancelled.**

On Friday, packets were sent out for students entering kindergarten for the 2020-2021 school year. If you did not receive one and have a child entering kindergarten next year please contact the district office so we can get one mailed to you. These packets contain the basic registration paperwork, how to get your PowerSchool Account set up, as well as information needed for the medical requirements to start kindergarten. If you know of new families in the district or any wishing to come to L-M next year please have them contact the school so we can get them started! If anyone is wondering, this will be the graduating class of 2033.

High School Immunizations and Screenings needed for the coming school year are: 9th grade students, certificate of dental screening completed by a dental provider or medical provider, a requirement letter and form were mailed earlier this year. 12th grade students will need up to date Tdap and MCVO4, meningitis vaccine must have proof of one after age 16.

Again, Iowa Department of Public Health will not be allowing a grace period for this requirement. If not submitted by the first day of school the student will be sent home and not allowed to attend school until this is completed. Due to the Coronavirus there will not be a vaccine clinic held at the school.
