**On Monday April 13, we began voluntary schooling services at Louisa-Muscatine. We have established a website, [lmlearning.org](http://lmlearning.org), a link can also be found on the district website. This website will be our centralized area for communicating our educational delivery. With much of our services being provided online we have checked out numerous computers to families needing a device. If you did not checkout a computer last week and are in need, please follow the check out procedure found on our website or call 319-726-3541. In addition to online engagement the elementary is providing PK-6 students with voluntary homework packets.**

**L-M bus drivers and volunteers delivered the voluntary homework packets to elementary students that currently ride our A.M. school bus routes. They delivered to regular bus stops within an approximate 10-minute window of normal morning bus route times. We then work on getting packets delivered later that day and Tuesday morning for families that we may have missed.**

**If you haven't received a packet or have not heard from the school, please call the central office so we can get in contact with you. In addition, if you need school supplies to complete any of the work provided please call the office and we will assist you in getting what you need.**

**Elementary Families- In your homework packet you will find your spring pictures. You have the option to purchase the pictures or to return them. If you wish to purchase them you may pay online using the information in the picture envelope or mail the payment to Louisa-Muscatine School District. If you do not wish to purchase the pictures you are asked to return them in a way that is safe for you. Each lunch delivery vehicle will be able to collect them, or you can return them to school once we are back in session.**

**Lunch pick-ups will continue in the same pick-up areas. Starting this week we are going to have hot lunch pick-ups on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with an extra sack lunch added to the Monday and Wednesday drops for lunches on Tuesday and Thursday. There will not be lunch pick-ups on Tuesday and Thursday. In this way we are able to provide the same amount of meals and reduce the amount social contact.**
